## FLORIDA STATE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS - 2018 - BEWARE OF BUNDLED AMENDMENTS

Many of the amendments have multiple, conflicting proposals bundled together. **We suggest a NO vote on all bundled amendments.**

**YES - AMENDMENT #3 – Voter Approval of Casino Gambling**—Removes authority to expand gambling from the legislature and returns it to the voters.

**YES - AMENDMENT #4 - Rights Restoration**—Florida is one of only four states that do not automatically restore voting rights to non-violent citizens who have completed their sentences, parole or restitution. In Florida, these citizens must wait an additional five to seven years before they can apply to have their voting rights restored. This affects 1.68 Million Floridians--all types of people from every walk of life. They have paid for their mistake and earned the right to vote!

**YES - AMENDMENT #9 – Bans Offshore Oil and Gas Drilling and Vaping in Enclosed Indoor Workspaces**—Concerns for the environment overrides concern about putting vaping in the Constitution.

**YES - BALLOT AMENDMENT #13 – Ban on Wagering on Dog Racing**—This amendment would outlaw the cruel practice of dog racing. These animals are kept in cages, and are bred exclusively for the purposes of being used for profit in wagering.
