### **Vote by Mail Ballot Information**

Vote by Mail ballots are available for all voters. Each voter casting a vote by mail ballot must sign a "Voter's Certificate" per F.S. 101.64.

The Supervisor of Elections can accept requests for vote by mail ballots only from the voter, members of the voter's immediate family, or legal guardian. All written requests must be signed per F.S. 101.62(1)(a) and (b).

Immediate Family means the voter's spouse, or the parent, child, grandparent, or sibling of the voter or of the voter's spouse.

When requesting a vote by mail ballot, the voter must provide the following information per F.S. 101.62(1)(b):

- 1) Name;
- 2) Residence Address; and
- 3) Date of Birth.

If a family member or legal guardian makes a request for a vote by mail ballot, the requester must provide all information listed above plus the requester's per F.S. 101.62(1)(b):

- 1) Name;
- 2) Address;
- 3) Relationship to Voter;
- 4) The requester's driver's license number, if available; and
- 5) The requester's signature (written requests only).

#### **Definition of UOCAVA Voter:**

United States citizens covered by UOCAVA include:

- Members of the United States Uniformed Services and merchant marine;
- Their family members; and
- United States citizens residing outside the United States.

"Absent uniformed services voter" means:

- ✓ A member of a uniformed service on active duty who, by reason of such active duty, is absent from the place of residence where the member is otherwise qualified to vote;
- ✓ A member of the Merchant Marine who, by reason of service in the Merchant Marine, is absent from the place of residence where the member is otherwise qualified to vote;
- ✓ A spouse or dependent of a member described above who, by reason of the active duty of service of the member, is absent from the place of residence where the spouse or dependent is otherwise qualified to vote.

"Overseas voter means:

- ❖ An absent uniformed services voter who, by reason of active duty or service, is absent from the United States on the date of the election involved;
- ❖ A person who resides outside the United States and who is qualified to vote in the last place where the person was domiciled before leaving the United States;
- ❖ A person who resides outside the United States and, but for such residence, would be qualified to vote in the last place where the person was domiciled before leaving the United States.
